



# CITY OF SHEBOYGAN FALLS (RESIDENTS ONLY) GUIDE TO RECYCLING



## NEW GARBAGE COLLECTION RULES *Effective 1/02/2013*

Garbage must be placed in clear plastic bags, no larger than 33 gallons with a ten (10) bag limit and a fifty (50) pound weight limit.

Recycling: glass, plastic, aluminum, tin cans, newspapers, magazines, junk mail and cardboard must be placed in blue plastic recycling bags with no limit.

Material not accepted curbside will be construction debris, furniture, appliances with or without freon, cement, tires, e-waste, batteries, oil, hazardous waste, items weighing more than fifty (50) pounds and other items the State or Federal Government disallows.

All household garbage and recyclables must be placed at the curb no earlier than 4:00 P.M. the day before the collection and no later than 7:00 A.M. the day of collection.

### ACCEPTABLE CONTAINER PRODUCTS

Aluminum Cans, Trays, and Foil

Steel & Tin Cans (Food Cans ONLY)

Glass Jars - Clear, Green, and Brown

#1 Plastic - Soda and Water Beverage Bottles, Peanut Butter Jars - PETE

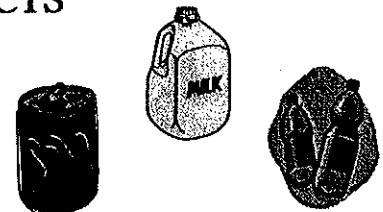
#2 Plastic - Milk & Juice Jugs, Detergent Bottles, Yogurt Cups - HDPE

#3 Plastic - NARROW NECK CONTAINER ONLY. Water Bottles, Liquid Detergent, Household Cleaners.

#4 Plastic - Margarine Tubs, frozen dessert cups, 6 pk, 12 pk rings, food storage containers - LDPE

#5 Plastic - Yogurt Cups, narrow neck syrup and ketchup bottles - PP

#7 Plastic - Plastic Narrow Neck Containers ONLY

Ceramics

Plastic Toys

Flower Pots

Drinking Glasses

Light Bulbs

Window or Auto Glass

Plastic Bags

No Caps or Lids

### ACCEPTABLE PAPER PRODUCTS

Newspapers including inserts

Cardboard (no waxed cardboard)

Brown Paper Bags

Shredded Paper

Magazines, Catalogs, Phonebooks

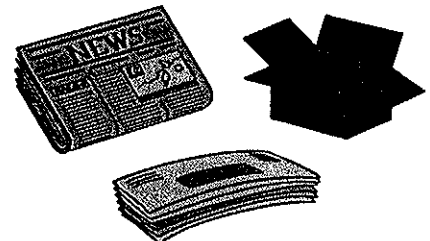
Office, Computer, Notebook

Chipboard (cereal, cake and food mix boxes, any plastic liners removed)

Carrier Stock (Soda & Beer Carrying Cases)

Junk Mail & Envelopes (including window envelopes)

Paperback Books (hard cover with front and backs removed)



### UNACCEPTABLE PAPER PRODUCTS (*place in trash*)

Styrofoam

Tissue Products/Paper Toweling

Dairy Carton Boxes

Holiday Wrapping Paper

Frozen Food Boxes

Pizza Boxes or Carryout Wrappers

Contaminated Paper

**1/02/2013 Garbage Collection – NEW RULES**

**Garbage must be placed in clear plastic bags, no larger than 33 gallons with a ten (10) bag limit and fifty (50) pound weight limit.**

**Recycling: glass, plastic, aluminum, tin cans, newspapers, magazines, junk mail and cardboard must be placed in blue plastic recycling bags with no limit.**

**Material not accepted curbside will be construction debris, furniture, appliances with or without freon, cement, tires, e-waste, batteries, oil, hazardous waste, items weighing more than fifty (50) pounds and other items the State or Federal Government disallows.**

**All household garbage and recyclables must be placed at the curb no earlier than 4:00 P.M. the day before the collection and no later than 7:00 A.M. the day of collection.**
